



Specifically, our projects ban harmful CFCs and HCFCs, instead prioritizing environmentally friendly alternatives with lower emissions profiles.

This practice significantly minimizes climate impact and aligns with international environmental standards such as ISO 14001.



Standardized Monthly Emissions Reporting (Scope 1, 2 and 3)

Comprehensive systems for monthly tracking of Scope 1, Scope 2 and Scope 3 emissions will be established, leveraging advanced analytics for accurate emission quantification and management, enhancing transparency and driving informed decision-making.

Zoned designs reduce energy in unused areas, while VRF precisely matches refrigerant flow to realtime demands.

VFDs dynamically adjust motor speeds based on actual HVAC loads, further cutting energy usage. ERVs recover thermal energy from exhaust air, enhancing efficiency and indoor air quality.

Collectively, these technologies significantly reduce energy consumption emissions. supporting TMG-SAUDI's sustainability goals.







Recycled Water for Irrigation
